

# **Teacher Education Scholarships Four Full-Tuition Scholarships Available for Minority Students**

**Southeastern College at Wake Forest (a School of Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary) makes available four scholarships for four minority students -- two African-American and two Hispanic -- who want to pursue a degree in secondary teacher education. Eligible students must seek to complete a degree in one of the two teaching disciplines offered through Southeastern College -- social studies or English. Qualified students must meet the requirements for admission to Southeastern College. In addition, applicants must complete the scholarship application, including a 250-word essay in which he/she expresses his/her interest in teaching.**

**Recipients will receive the following:**

- , Full tuition for eight semesters**
- , Tuition for summer or January course work taken at Southeastern and needed for graduation**

**(Room and board are not included.)**

**Recipients must do the following:**

- , Maintain a 3.0 cumulative average for all course work.**
- , Receive passing scores on PRAXIS exam prior to junior year.**
- , Complete all course work necessary to receive a North Carolina license in Secondary English or Social Studies.**
- , Student must take a minimum of 12 hours a semester.**
- , Applications can be printed from the Teacher Education website or you may obtain a copy from the Student Life Office, Ledford Center.**
- , Deadline for application is June 1, 2006.**
